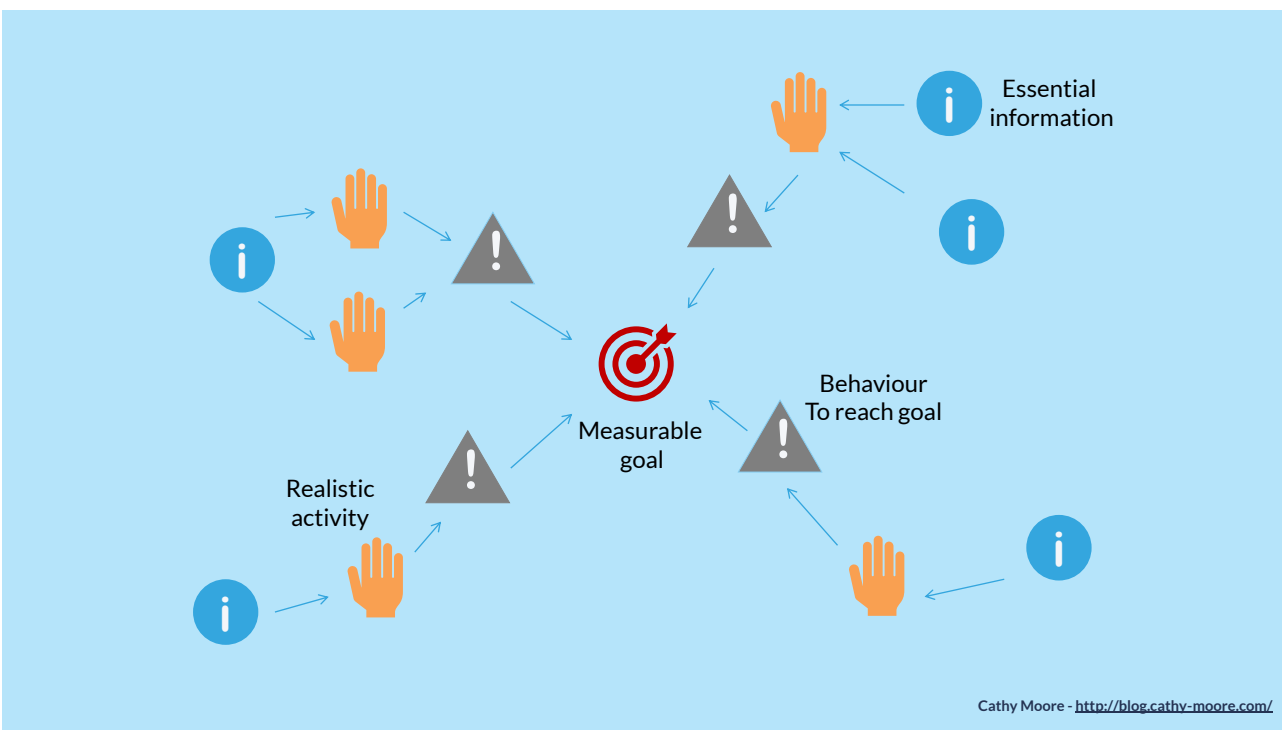

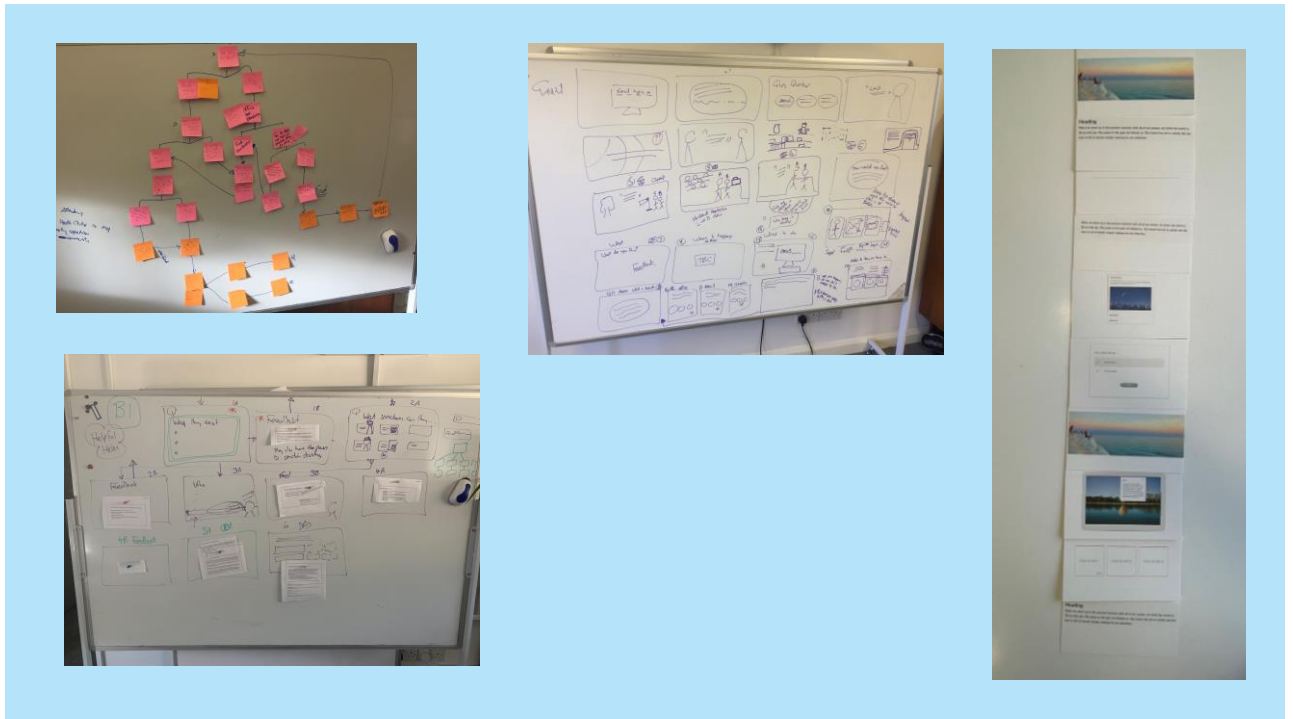

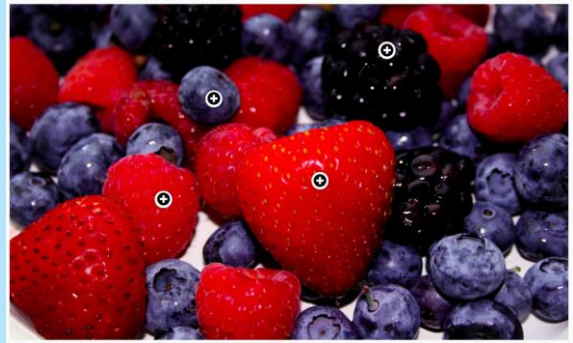

- Scandinavia has strict rules for harvesting cloudberries. Sweden even has a section for regulating this in their Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

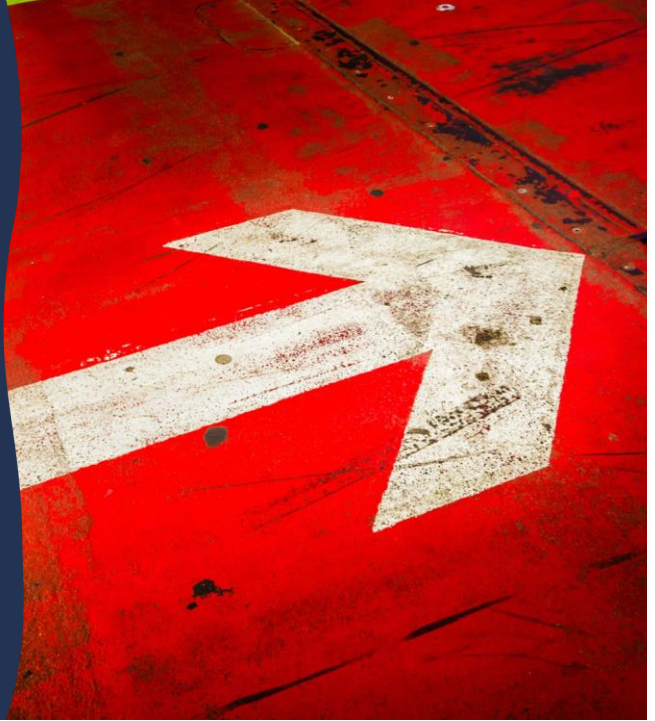

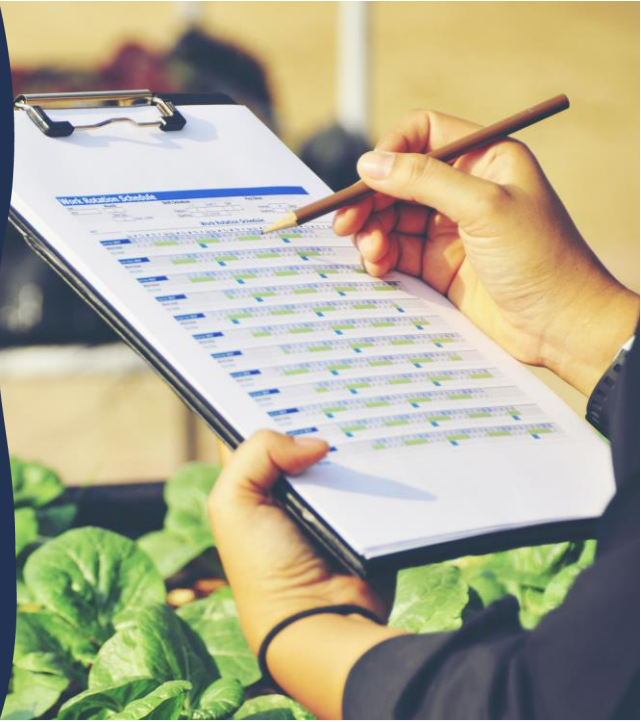
